Public Notice

Government of India has decided to include the service for re-issue of IDP as one of the consular services provided by Indian Mission/Posts abroad w.e.f **15th February, 2021**.

2. International Driving Permit (IDP) helps the Indian Citizen to drive vehicle as per Indian Driving Licence, in foreign country which are the signatory of Geneva Convention on Road Traffic, 1949. The IDP is issued only one year only and does not have any provision for its renewal. Presently, the applicants are required to apply for re-issue of IDP in India only.

3. The process for applying for re-issue of IDP will involve the following steps:

- Applicant will visit Mission and fill the Miscellaneous Consular Service form to avail consular service. The fee will be **CFA 6000+** ICWF charges for the application for re-issue of International Driving Permit.

- Submit a copy of a valid domestic driving license issued by Government of India, a copy of expired IDP, one recent photo, copy of passport & copy of valid visa.

- The Mission/Post will issue a receipt to the applicant with following details on it:

(a) Name of the applicant as per Passport

(b) Expired IDP number of the applicant

(c) Consular officer certifying that applicant is the same as per passport photo on the expired IDP and is holding a valid domestic driving licence issued by Government of India

(d) QR Code/ service number/ receipt number may also be put on the receipt.

4. Applicant will apply for fresh issue of IDP through the portal www.parivahan.gov.in and will upload the documents, including the receipt issued by Indian Mission/ Post abroad as mandated under the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989. On receipt of application through the portal, the licencing authority, on verification of the documents, shall issue the IDP and shall courier it directly to the address of the applicant.
